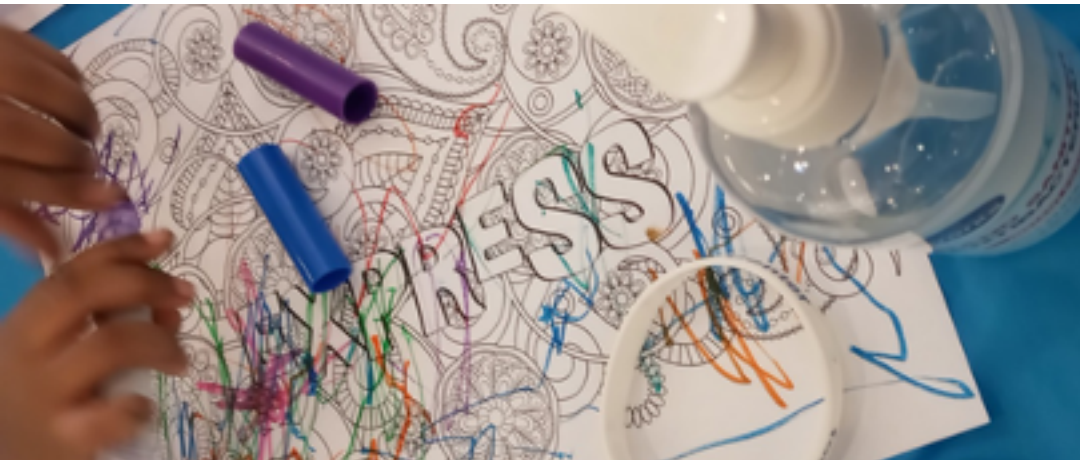


The Greater Philadelphia Grief Collaborative

Uplift: Center for Grieving Children



Services Offered:

- Peer Support Groups for ages kindergarten to high school, with concurrent caregiver groups.
Virtual via Zoom and In-Person Options
- Specialty Grief Groups: Spanish, LGBTQ+, and Resilient Parenting for Bereaved Families.
- In-School Groups for elementary through high school in Philadelphia.
- Training and Professional Development

Safe Harbor

Services Offered:

- Peer Support Groups for ages four to high school, with concurrent caregiver groups.
- Peer Support Groups for Young Adults ages 19 to 29.
- School Outreach for Bereavement Support for local school districts.
- Camp Charlie: A weeklong bereavement camp for children ages 6 to 12 who have experienced the death of a parent, sibling, or primary caregiver.

Peter's Place: A Center for Grieving Children & Families



Services Offered:

- Peer Support Groups for ages four to high school, with concurrent caregiver groups.
- School-Based Groups in Philadelphia and the five-county area.
- Postvention Services: A curated customized response that facilitates discussion when a tragic loss occurs in a school or community.
- Ryan's Hope Program: A group specifically for parents who had an adult child die from substance use or mental illness.
- Virtual Grief Support Groups via Zoom for Adults.

- Grief Support Groups and Outreach for Schools and Community Organizations.

- Camp Millie: Four-Day Summer Peer Support Program for youth ages 6 to 14.
